### ENTRY INFORMATION

- Limited to 5 hanging pieces of art per artist
- Quilts limited to 2 large 60" or more per artist
- All artwork must be ready to hang on wire or rods for quilts

### FEES

- Single framed hanging entry.....\$6.00
- Portfolio.....\$15.00
- Display table.....\$15.00

### ENTRY DIRECTIONS

Please reply by either email or phone by Monday, August 22, 2016 to confirm your entry in the show and how many pieces you plan to exhibit. Space is limited, so we ask you to please confirm to us ASAP.

This year's Art Show will be at the Tupper Lake Train Station September 1-3, 2016. Drop-offs of your art works, filling out entry forms, and completion of labels for artworks will be August 30 and 31 at the Train Station, 8am-7pm each day. At that time a check made out to The Tupper Lake Arts Council should also be presented. We will provide the labels for display of your artworks.

The Tupper Lake Arts Council will retain 20% commission on all work sold.

As always, Art Show volunteers and members of the Arts Council will exercise great care in handling and hanging the exhibits. However, we cannot assume responsibility for loss or damage.
